If you're worried about birds eating your cherry trees, there are a few things you can do to keep them away. Try hanging shiny items on the outside of your trees, like old CDs, aluminum pie tins, and scrunched up sheets of tin foil. Hang them from string about 5 feet apart to keep birds away.

The cibrate weevil is a cherry tree pest that damages the leaves of the tree, as cited by the University of California Extension. Cibrate weevils are 0.5 inches long and dark brown in color. The nocturnal insects feed on the tree at night, hiding in the dirt below the tree in the daytime.

Sweet cherry trees take about 4 to 7 years after planting (on average) before they bloom or bear fruit. Pie/Sour/Tart cherry trees bear a little sooner, within 3 to 5 years after planting. If enough time has been allowed to pass, and the cherry tree is otherwise healthy, there are a few things to do to help it become fruitful.

Tree and Shrub Food is Perfect for Cherry Trees As the buds start to form on the tree in the early spring, increase your fertilizing range to beyond the drip line to spur new growth in the roots. Try mulching around the base of the tree during the growing season. Make sure you use a high-quality, organic compost for best results.
