### Security Classification Guidance - CDSE

Classification levels are applied to classified information based on the level of damage that could reasonably be expected to be caused to national security if unauthorized disclosure of that information occurs. The unauthorized disclosure of Confidential information could reasonably be expected to cause damage to national security.
